

Mrs. Funk's plan to encourage good behavior.



Our class will use a clip chart behavior management system this year. This system promotes positive behavior choices and encourages students to self-monitor their behavior. *See attached for reference guide.

How It Works....

- Each student has a clothespin labeled with his/her name, and begins the day clipped to the center of the chart labeled "Let's Rock n Roll (ready to learn)"
- During the day students will have the opportunity to move their clothespin; up for positive behavior or down for inappropriate behavior.
- Rewards and Consequences are awarded according to the color students are on at the end of the day.

Clip Chart Advantages

- Students are acknowledged for positive behavior choices.
- Students who display inappropriate behavior always have the opportunity to change their behavior and move back up on the chart.
- Students feel a sense of accomplishment when they make good behavior choices and have the chance to "clip up".

Off the Chart	Good behavior recess & wear "clip up necklace"
Top of the Chart	Good behavior recess & decoration for clip
Red	Good behavior recess & star on the "Hall of Fame"
Orange	Good Behavior Recess & sign the "Autograph Wall"
Yellow	Good behavior recess & 1 cent for class store
Green	Good behavior recess & 1 cent for class store
Blue	Miss 5 minutes of good behavior recess
Purple	Parent contact & no recess
Pink	Parent & principal contact & no recess

***Students that do not complete their assignments throughout the day will also spend time inside during good behavior recess in order to complete their work.
